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DIRECTIONS

Train: Amtrak From NYC Penn Station to Rhinecliff, (845) 876-3364; 1-800-USA-RAIL, 523-7000. You must take a taxi from station.

Car: From NYC and South North on NYS Thruway to Exit 19. First right on traffic circle to Rt. 28 (west), Rt. 28 to Rt. 375 (traffic light) Turn right on Rt. 375 to Route 212 into Woodstock Village. Make a left turn into village. From Albany and North South on NYS Thruway to Exit 20 (Saugerties). Left on Rt. 32 several hundred feet to Rt. 212 (traffic light). Right on Rt. 212 into Woodstock (ten miles). **Bus:** Adirondack
